IMMIGRATION OVERVIEW

Definitions:

- Immigration the movement of people into another country or region to which they are not native in order to settle there.
- **Immigrant –** a person who migrates to another country, usually for permanent residence.

Some Statistics

- Of the more than 31 million foreignborn people living in the US, 75% are legal immigrants with permanent visas. Of the remaining 25% that are undocumented, nearly half (45%) of them entered the country legally and then let their papers expire.
- There are approximately a half million illegal entries into the United States each year.
- An estimated half to three quarters of undocumented immigrants pay federal, state, and local taxes, including up to \$7 billion in social security taxes for benefits they will never get.
- The majority of immigrants speak English well, but the demand for ESL instruction far exceeds the available classes.
- In 2011 at least 5,100 citizen children of undocumented immigrants were living in foster care because their parents were detained or deported.
